PARTICIPATION RIBBONS ONLY - NO CASH AWARDS

Young exhibitors who are not yet old enough to show Youth Livestock will have the opportunity to learn about showmanship skills from the older youth who are members of our Youth Advisory Council. This is a fun and educational show. Open to Youth Exhibitors ages 5 through 8 or who have completed Kindergarten through 3rd Grade, as of opening day of the San Joaquin Fair.

Species allowed: Rabbits, Cavies & Pygmy Goats (no horns).

This is a one day, carry-in show. **One Animal per Exhibitor.**

DIV. 700 PRE-JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASS

1. Cavy Showmanship
2. Pygmy Goat Showmanship Pre-Junior must be able to control animal
3. Rabbit Showmanship
4. Costume Class

Rules and Information:

1. Demonstrations given by older youth on showmanship in each specie.
2. Exhibitor to perform showmanship routine after demonstration.
3. Participation in Showmanship (class 1-4) is required to participate in Costume (class 5).
4. All species shown separately for showmanship class.
5. All species shown together for costume class.
6. Additional ribbons awarded in costume class, such as fair theme, best pair, most creative, funniest, and judges' choice.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries in showmanship must be made at the same time as your market and breeding livestock entries. Exhibitors shall be on hand and ready to exhibit at the time called for judging.

**WINNER OF ADVANCED SHOWMANSHIP MUST COMMIT TO
PARTICIPATING IN MASTER SHOWMANSHIP WITHIN ONE HOUR AFTER
COMPLETION OF COMPETITION.**

NOVICE SHOWMANSHIP: Open to 4-H, Grange and Independent exhibitors, 12 and under, who have not shown any specie of animal at any Fair. FFA has no age requirements. Winner of this class may compete up in the next respective age class.

INTERMEDIATE SHOWMANSHIP: Open to 4-H, Grange exhibitors between the age of 9 and 14 as of January 1st. Winner of this class may compete in advanced class for premiums.

ADVANCED SHOWMANSHIP: Open to those 4-H, FFA or Grange exhibitors who are 15 years of age or older as of January 1st.

4-H, FFA & GRANGE SHOWMANSHIP

Animals that are entered into the Fair with good intention of qualifying for judging may be used for Showmanship by the owner even if the animal is disqualified by weight, or by the judge. Animals must be owned and fitted by the exhibitor to qualify. No Nurse Cows will be allowed in showmanship competition for safety reasons. All exhibitors should wear the official show uniform of the organization they represent.

The Showmanship Classes will be judged in accordance with the following score card:

APPEARANCE OF ANIMALS	40%
Condition (10%)	
Grooming and/or clipping (20%)	
Cleanliness (10%)	
APPEARANCE OF EXHIBITOR.....	10%
SHOWING IN THE RING	50%
Moving or leading (15%)	
Posing (15%)	
Show animal to best advantage (10%)	
Poise, alertness and attitude (10%)	
TOTAL	100%

Winners of Master Showmanship are eligible to compete in the State Fair Master Showmanship Competition. The Exhibitor is responsible and must pick up the County Fair Best of Show Entry Form at the SJ Fair Administration Office immediately following competition. The Entry Form must be submitted by the Exhibitor to the State Fair subject to State Fair rules and regulations. Past Fair Best of Show Master Showmanship winners are not eligible to compete in future San Joaquin Fair Master Showmanship competitions.

All first place winners from this year's Advanced 4-H/Grande and FFA/Grande Showmanship in Boer Goats, Breeding Beef, Breeding Sheep, Breeding Swine, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Market Beef, Market Sheep, Market Swine, Market Goats are eligible to compete. Any exhibitor winning in more than one specie of Advanced Showmanship can choose one specie to represent; the 2nd place winner of the remaining specie is then eligible to compete. If for any reason, the first place winner of a specie does not compete, then the second place winner of that specie is eligible to compete and notify Livestock office.

All first place winners from this year's Advanced 4-H/Grande and FFA/Grande Showmanship in Breeding Poultry, Rabbits, Pygmy Goats, Market Turkey, Meat Rabbits and the Best Dog Handler, if a 4-H member, are eligible to compete. Any exhibitor winning in more than one specie of Advanced Showmanship can choose one specie to represent; the 2nd place winner of the remaining specie is then eligible to compete. If for any reason, the first place winner of a specie does not compete, then the second place winner of that specie is eligible to compete and notify Livestock office.
