RULES & INFORMATION:

1. All FFA, 4-H and Grange exhibitors are encouraged to wear the official uniform of their organization. Independent exhibitors may wear white pants and white shirts.
2. Use one Livestock entry form for all dogs entered by Exhibitor.
3. 4-H exhibitors must be currently enrolled in a Dog Care and Training Project, and be a member in good standing.
4. Dogs must be on a leash at all times (except during appropriate obedience classes) and under control. Unruly or aggressive dogs will be removed.
5. Dogs will not be allowed in the livestock barns.
6. Owners will clean up after their own animals.
7. All exhibitors must possess valid Rabies and Parvo vaccination papers for their dogs.
8. Bitches in season will NOT be allowed on the Fairgrounds.
9. No exhibitor may handle more than one dog in any one class. Exhibitors may show more than one dog, but the dogs must be in different classes. One obedience class per dog.
10. Judging and scoring will be according to A.K.C. regulations.
11. The Fair reserves the right to limit entries based on time available for judging.

RULES & INFORMATION:

1. Enter on the Poultry Entry Form, available on the web page www.sanjoaquinfair.com or the Joaquin Fair Office. List division, class, breed, variety, sex classification on all birds entered. Leg bands number are optional on the entry form. Leg bands numbers must be placed on coop cards before judging as your entry with be disqualified with out leg band numbers.
2. Judging shall be based on the latest editions of the American Standard of Perfection, copyrighted by the A.P.A. and the Bantam Standard, copyrighted by the A.B.A.
3. Fair management reserves the right to combine any classes it deems necessary in order to assure adequate competition and to reclassify any entry entered in the wrong class.
4. Substitutions can only be made within a division and will be made at coop-in. A \$5 fee will be charged per change in accordance with State Rules.
5. The exhibitor must own breeding and market poultry for at least 30 days prior to the first day of the fair.
6. An exhibitor is allowed to show 2 large market animals or 2 small market animals or 1 of each in either 4-H, FFA or Grange. (Pair of Meat Birds is considered 1 small animal exhibit.) Dairy Replacement Heifer included in this rule.
7. All poultry will be inspected prior to coop-in, on the grass at the west side of Building 1, upon arrival as required by the California Department of Food and Agriculture. Any bird showing evidence of parasite infestation, disease or illness will not be allowed to enter the fairgrounds. Inspected Breeding & Meat Bird are to be delivered to Building #1 for Coop-In.
8. All birds must be clean and represent the highest quality and standards of that breed.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for the feeding, watering & care of their bird each day
10. Birds are to be handled by owner, judge, and show officials only.
11. The Fair is not responsible for the death, loss, sickness or injury of any entry, although all care will be taken to protect the animals.
12. All crates, boxes, etc. used for delivery of animals must be removed from the grounds as soon as the animals are coop-ed.
13. Release cards must be obtained from the Livestock Office when birds are checked out. Birds not called for will be disposed of.
14. All Champion and Reserve Champion Turkey and Pair of Meat Birds must sell in the auction, if owned by same exhibitor he/she may only sell one (Exhibitors Choice). Sale champions must remain on display the duration of the Fair
15. All exhibitors are expected to actively participate in barn duty. Daily shifts are required when poultry are on the fairgrounds. Please make necessary arrangements to participate.

RULES & INFORMATION

The following rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the Guide Book and standard of the American Rabbit Breeders' Association, Inc., shall apply to all district and county fair rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture:

1. All entries must be entered on the **Rabbit Entry Form**.
2. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
3. Breed, variety, class and sex must be listed on the entry form.
4. All animals must be identified by permanent ear markings, conforming with the entry form, on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings by one exhibitor, in the same class, must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
5. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety, age and sex only. Disqualified rabbits and those absent at the time of judging do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the class and can not show in fur.
6. A judge may excuse a rabbit from competition because of temporary or curable defects, yet the rabbit shall be counted as an entry.
7. Birth date must be listed on entry form for single fryer.
8. Fur entries must be entered in their regular classes. All Fur entries are judged together.
9. The exhibitor must own rabbits for at least 30 days prior to the fair.
10. Champion and Reserve Champion Single Fryer must sell in the auction, if owned by same Exhibitor he/she may only sell one (Exhibitors Choice) All Blue Ribbon market animals are eligible to sell in the Youth Livestock Auction. Sale animals must remain on display the duration of the Fair.
11. An exhibitor is allowed to show 2 large market animals, including dairy replacement heifer or 2 small market animals or 1 of each in either 4-H, FFA or Grange.
12. All FFA, 4-H and Grange exhibitors are encouraged to wear the official uniform of their organization. Independent Exhibitors may wear white pants and shirts.
13. The Fair is not responsible for the death, loss, or injury of any entry although all care will be taken to protect the animal.

**EXHIBITORS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN
FEED AND WATER DISHES**

Livestock vehicles (cars and trucks) may be admitted onto the Fairgrounds for drop off purposes only until 9 a.m. no parking allowed, don't leave your car unattended. Unauthorized vehicles still on the grounds will be removed at the expense of the owner. This rule must be enforced for the safety of all fair visitors.

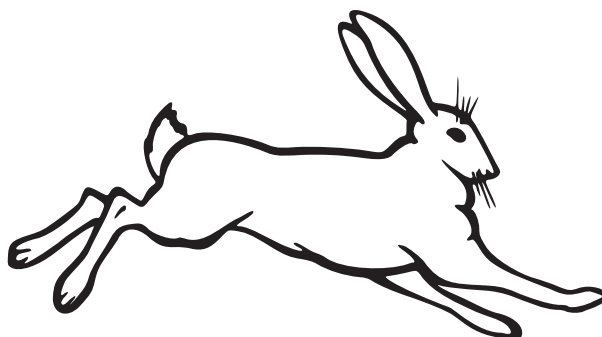
