# RULES & INFORMATION

(Pre-registration required for Showmanship)

**OPEN TO JUNIOR RESIDENTS OF SAN JOAQUIN**

**COUNTY ONLY - SEE SPECIFIC DIVISIONS**

**ALL JUNIOR RULES APPLY**

1. All Goats, Lambs and Sheep arriving at the fair will be inspected prior to off-loading. Animals showing evidence of any communicable disease will not be allowed to off-load and show and must be removed from the Fairgrounds immediately. All sheep and goats must have either a scrapie tag in the ear or a legible tattoo upon arriving at the fairgrounds.
2. No person shall be allowed to interfere with the health inspection or offer any audible criticism of any kind. Violators will be excused immediately from the competition and be subject to other penalties as management shall consider proper. Inspection decisions are final and may not be protested.
3. Muzzling of any animal is prohibited.
4. To qualify for exhibit, lambs and sheep must be docked such that the tail (dock) is healed and can be lifted from the exterior. Lambs that have no dock will not be eligible. Breeding animals born before Jan 1, 2000 are exempt.
5. The Fair does not provide any bedding for large animals. All animals will be bedded on straw or shaving, please see species bedding rules. Exhibitors may show out of your trailer. If a Pen is used, Exhibitor must clean Pen before being released. If violated, Premiums will be withheld.

All registered animals must be permanently identified prior to entry on the Fairgrounds or they will be disqualified:

1. Beef, dairy cattle, dairy goats, and Boer goats must be tattooed. Holsteins will meet association I.D. requirements.
2. Sheep must have both scrapie and flock tags.
3. Hogs must be ear notched.

To qualify for entry and judging, the following information must be provided on the entry form by the closing date of entry:

1. Identification of each animal at least by: dam, birth date, ear tag, notching, tattoo, or the registration number.
2. Registration number of the sire for Get of Sire entries.
3. Registration number of the dam for Produce of Dam entries.

If the above information is completed after close of entry, a \$5 penalty fee per entry may be required by the Fair prior to judging to qualify for judging.

**The Fair Management reserves the right to combine or separate breeds according to entry.**

### **TWO YEAR PROGRAM**

Any exhibitor who participates in a two year Replacement Heifer project is entitled to an additional \$40.00 Project Premium Award upon selling that heifer at the Replacement Heifer Auction. All Heifers must have been entered, shown and judged each year at the San Joaquin Fair to be eligible for the Project Premium Award.

### **TWO YEAR PROJECTS MUST USE THE STANDARD**

#### **REPLACEMENT HEIFER APPLICATION FORM THE FIRST YEAR**

1. **The exhibitor must be the owner of the animal by February 1 and registered with the Fair office by March 15 or the next bussiness day. The animal must shown must be entered, and judged at the San Joaquin Fair to qualify for sale.**
2. Service sire must be Registered and of the same breed as the Dam.
3. The dam must have no history of cross breeding and have production records.
4. Heifers should have been born in June - September of previous year to qualify.
5. Heifers must be from a Dam that has good type and has met the minimum milk and butterfat production. Mature equivalent may be used.
6. Bred date may not be prior to October 7. Heifers that calf prior to arriving at the Fair will not be allowed to show or sell.
7. The member must have the heifer pregnancy checked & and verification delivered to the San Joaquin Fair Office by March 15 or next business day.
8. Heifer must be identified by DHIA accepted number with a California Brucellosis ear tag. A readable vaccination (bangs) tattoo must be present in heifer's ear when arriving at the fair, shield is optional.
9. All heifers must submit to and pass a vet check.
10. If registration information is completed after due dates, a \$50.00 penalty will be required to qualify for judging.
11. All animals will be bedded on straw. Rice straw is prohibited.
12. Complete rules & information available at the Fair Administration Office.
13. If an Exhibitor has another specie of animal and received a champion. Champion **MUST SELL** which dis qualifies the Heifer from the sale.

1. Females Only. Any female over 24 months of age that has not kidded or have proof of current pregnancy will not be allowed to show.
2. Birthdates as listed on registration certificate will determine classes. Classes may be combined at Fair Management discretion.
3. All goats must be registered in the Herdbook of American Boer Goat Assn., International Boer Goat Assn., the Canadian Boer Goat Assn., or the USBGA. Original registration cert. is required and must be in the owners name. Information on transfers is not acceptable.
4. All animals must be registered purebred or percentage blood and the registration papers must match tattoo(s) or other means of permanent identification or the animal will not be shown. If the animal has a microchip as its permanent ID, the exhibitor is responsible for providing reader. Tattoo policy will be strictly enforced.
5. Any goat showing pronounced defects or abnormalities may not show.
6. Fittings at the discretion of the exhibitor. No artificial coloring allowed.
7. No show collars with spikes allowed.
8. The Fair does not provide any bedding for large animals. All animals will be bedded on shavings. Exhibitors may show out of trailer. If a Pen is used, Exhibitor must clean Pen before being released. If violated Premiums will be withheld. Rice straw and sprays are prohibited.
9. All Grade Does must have a scrapie tag.

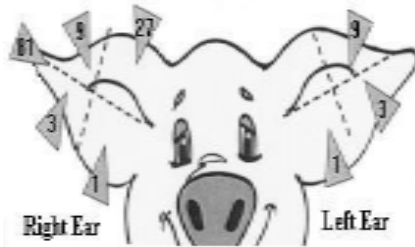
