1. Animals in Market Goat classes must have been owned by Exhibitor for 60 days prior to opening day of the fair.
2. Independent Exhibitors must submit to the Fair a photo of the animal no later than 60 days prior to the opening of the Fair.
3. Goats must have milk teeth.
4. **Goats should be disbudded. Goats with horns, or scurs can not be longer than 2" and must be tipped.**
5. All goats will be bedded on shavings. Only Bedding Bags will be permitted on top of shavings and must be kept clean at all times. Rice straw is prohibited.
6. Goats must be shorn within 10 days prior to being shown and have no more than 1/4" of hair growth left anywhere except below the knees and hocks and tail switch.
7. Meat Goats must have scrapie tag in the ear upon arrival at the fairgrounds.
8. Castration sites shall be healed & free of inflammation.

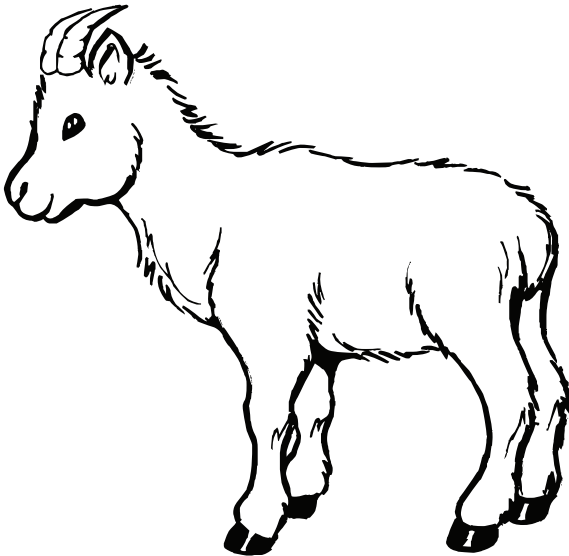

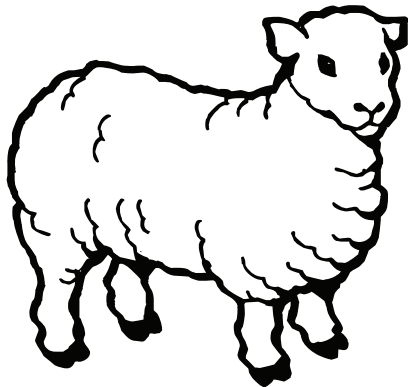

**Please make a hole in ear for fair tag**



All market Lambs must arrive at the Fair for the Health Check Clean Slick Shorn from the knee, hock and head with a show blade (i.e. fine tooth or surgicals) **ready to show**. Woll to be no longer than 1/4" stretched. Sheep with excessive wool will not behealth inspected and demmed ineligible for exhibit unless the above sheering requirements are followed. Touch up Shearing will be allowed before show.

### **RULES & INFORMATION:**

(Please refer to additional rules listed in this guidebook)

1. Goats, Lambs and Sheep arriving at the fair will be inspected prior to off loading. Animals showing evidence of any communicable disease will not be allowed to off-load and exhibit and must be removed from the Fairgrounds immediately. Inspection decisions are final and may not be protested.
2. No person shall be allowed to interfere with the health inspection or offer any audible criticism of any kind. Violators will be excused immediately from the competition and be subject to other penalties as management shall consider proper.
3. Muzzling of all animals is prohibited.
4. Bill of sale required for market lambs and must be turned in when ear tagged. Indicate breeder name on entry form.
5. To qualify for exhibit, lambs and sheep must be docked such that the tail (dock) is healed and can be lifted from the exterior.
6. *The Fair does not provide any bedding for large animals*  
All sheep will be bedded on shavings only. Only Bedding Bags will be permitted on top of shavings and must be kept clean at all times. Rice straw, mats, nets and sprays are prohibited.
7. Remove all tags from the animal except scrappie and CA State Fair DNA tag. All flock/herd and/or private tags must be removed prior to arrival at the fair.
8. Castration sites shall be healed and free of inflammations.

**Market Ready:** USDA Prime or Choice quality with 12th rib back fat range .16-.35, average or greater conformation & cutability. **Eligible for Sale.**

**Not Market Ready:** Good or lower quality grade with 12th rib back fat range <.16 or >.35; underfinished lambs grading USDA good or lower, below-average conformation or cutability. **Not Eligible for Sale.**

## DANISH SYSTEM OF JUDGING

### RULES & INFORMATION:

Please refer to additional rules listed in this guidebook

1. Exhibitor's age must be on entry form.
2. Barrows and Gilts only.
3. Gilts entered in this division may not be entered in breeding divisions.
4. Hogs must be free of excessive mud to allow for a reasonable health inspection for parasites. Lice or ticks must be treated prior to arrival.
5. An ear notch drawing on the entry form will be appreciated.
6. The Fair does not provide any bedding for large animals. All Swine will be bedded on shavings. Only Bedding Bags will be permitted on top of shavings, and must be kept clean at all times. Rice straw and sprays are prohibited.
7. After weighing, market hogs will be divided into weight lots within the 215 to 300 pound limitations as desired for convenience in judging. Hogs will NOT be paid for more than 280 pounds in the Junior Livestock Auction. Hogs over 300 lbs will not be allowed to sell but are eligible to enter showmanship if exhibitor's only animal .
8. Desired ear tag placement. The San Joaquin Fair issued ear tags should be placed in the pig's left ear for 4-H/Grange swine and in the pig's right ear for FFA/Grange swine. The tag will be placed with the number of the tag on the top side of the ear for easy identification.

### MARKET READY RIBBONS ONLY -NO CASH AWARDS

**Market Acceptable:** U.S. No. 1 and U.S. No. 2 hogs of average or greater conformation that are acceptable in leanness, muscularity and production traits. Eligible for Sale.

**Not Market Acceptable:** Any hog of below average conformation and/or muscling including U.S. No. 3, U.S. No. 4 and utility grade hogs. Not Eligible for Sale.
